


SOCIAL SYMBOL STRIP

T	Stay on topic
Eyes	Use eye contact
Bubble	Bubble that thought
Pencil	Get to the point
Hand	Raise your hand
Neutral Face	Have an appropriate reaction/keep a neutral facial expression



Social Symbol Strips are symbols that can be put on the child’s desk to help the child figure out what social cues s/he needs to modify. For example, if a child with a social disability is monopolizing a conversation, the teacher can point to the  sign to cue ‘get to the point’. This is a great and dignified way to help students recognize the social skills issue without drawing large attention to their issues.
